

6245 CM-Reports with CMRT

The "Dodd-Frank" Act of 2010 states that companies listed in the USA, with the help of their suppliers, must declare to the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) each year whether they use minerals from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or neighboring countries. If so, their origin and trade chains must be disclosed in a "conflict minerals report". It must be clarified whether the minerals used do not directly or indirectly benefit or finance armed groups in this Central African region. Even if these complicated regulations do not demonstrably reduce conflicts, the report is mandatory according to the "name and shame" principle.

Objective

You will be able to understand and communicate the information, requirements and obligations in the supply chain. You are able to generate the reporting according to the RMI reporting template CMRT and deliver it to your customers. You know roughly how to implement the objectives from the US law. You can assess how your company is affected.
