

The EMRT (Extended Minerals Reporting Template) was created by the RBA (Responsible Business Alliance). Unlike the CMRT, which is linked to the Dodd-Frank Act, there are currently no legal requirements for the EMRT. In general, conflict minerals are raw materials or natural resources that are often mined or extracted illegally and without government control in conflict regions and high-risk areas. Systematic violations of human rights and international law go hand in hand with this. This means EMRT reporting is a corporate social responsibility (CSR) and corporate due diligence issue.

Learning objectives

You will gain an understanding of how your supply chain is affected and which documentation and information sharing requirements you and your suppliers need to meet.
