

The REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 builds the foundation of European chemicals legislation and is considered one of the most comprehensive regulatory frameworks worldwide. Its objective is to enhance the protection of human health and the environment from risks posed by chemical substances while simultaneously promoting innovation and competitiveness within industry.

REACH regulates the registration, evaluation, authorization, and restriction of chemical substances and requires companies to ensure their safe use throughout the entire lifecycle.

As REACH is regarded as a global benchmark, many countries have introduced comparable systems—including UK REACH, Turkey’s KKDİK regulation, K-REACH in South Korea, and China REACH. While these systems are structurally based on the EU framework, they differ in timelines, data requirements, and regulatory responsibilities.

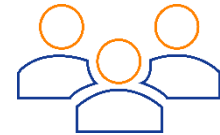
