

iPCA – LCM (Life Cycle Management) is the area within iPCA used to manage master data, configuration settings, user privileges, and customer requests throughout the entire process. iPCA LCM provides structured and traceable processes for handling life cycle assessment topics and supports compliance and sustainability requirements through systematic data collection and management.

>> OBJECTIVE

You are familiar with the general process of customer requests and the terms and definitions in IPoint Compliance Agent. You will learn how to configure LCM and how to assign required privileges to users.

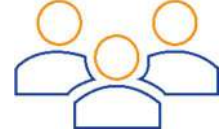
